Praise God, these were filled with joyful singing and we left encouraging the children to look for reminders of Jesus in the world around them this CHRISTmas. We pray they will remember Him when they see the lights in the darkness, the stars, the angels and the presents.

Our team of volunteers are simply amazing! They are so dedicated and passionate in their desire to share Jesus through our interactive and immersive Christmas Journey.

Praise God, over 950 local children have shared this experience with us this year. It's so precious as it's all about the Christ, our Saviour, Jesus. The interactive journey focusses on the Nativity and the children explore the scenes and 'meet the people' from the Gospel accounts. The experience is made all the more meaningful as we follow Jesus from Creation, through His miraculous birth on earth, His life, death, resurrection and, what all this means for us today. It is the Gospel and so full of wonder.

The teachers love this experience too and, praise God, we've had lovely feedback again this year:
