Assemblies for 3,000 Children – Celebrating God’s Big Family. We are preparing to lead a series of assemblies for around **3,000 local children**, exploring *Christianity around the world*. The children will discover how believers worship in different styles, cultures, and languages, and how the global Church reflects the beautiful diversity of God’s big family. Please pray that these assemblies will spark curiosity, joy, and a sense of belonging in every child who hears the message.

‘Diary of a Disciple’ Workshops – Encountering Jesus in Luke’s Gospel. We are also delighted to be running Scripture Union’s ‘Diary of a Disciple’ workshops for approximately **840 local children**. These sessions will take the children into Luke’s Gospel, helping them see how Jesus changes hearts and lives. Through the stories of **The Prodigal Son** and **Zacchaeus**, we pray that children will encounter God’s forgiveness, welcome, and transforming love.

Northern Gathering in Leeds – Growing with Scripture Union. Some of our team will be attending the **Scripture Union Northern Gathering in Leeds on 20th–21st April**. We are deeply blessed to be Mission Partners with Scripture Union, and we always value the chance to meet together, worship, pray, and learn. These gatherings help us grow in vision and strengthen our ministry, and we are thankful for the fellowship and wisdom they provide.

Sharing in Local Churches. We are grateful for upcoming opportunities to share about our schools work with **Inskip Baptist Church** and **The Well Church, Ansdell**. Encouraging churches and helping them see the impact of mission in schools is something we love. It is a joy to testify to what God is doing and to invite others into the story.
